



Skoog Educational Resources

The Skoog resources we provide are intended to help you get the most out of your Skoogs. Whether you want to be able to successfully use Skoog as an education tool or simply to get your pupils to explore the realms of musicality, Skoog educational resources will help you meet the needs of your classes.

Every resource is aimed at doing one of three things: using Skoog as a cross-curricular tool, using Skoog as an expressive arts tool, and using Skoog as a musical instrument.

Here is a brief look at the resources that are included:

Skoog Introductory Course

An introductory course written by experienced Skoog teacher Lewis Forbes to take you through all the basics for any students new to the Skoog.

Top Tunes & Transcriptions

These are specially selected and packaged notes that you can just drag and drop into the Skoogmusic software. Use them to improvise to your favourite tune (using an audio file as backing track or play via Youtube, for example), or play a riff or melody from the tune.

Lesson Plans

These are lesson plan suggestions and activity guides for incorporating the Skoog into your classroom that have been developed and written by music teachers and workshop leaders.

These lesson plans are normally in PDF format, and can be opened by softwares such as Adobe Reader and Apple Preview.

Samples/Backing Tracks

We have packaged up some samples and backing tracks based around different themes, which you can just drag and drop into the software, and instantly turn your Skoog into a sampler.

Score Notation Pack

Notes in .png format to help you write music with your Skoog!

Classroom's Got Talent

A series of lessons that get your class writing their own music on the Skoog, then performing to their classmates in a 'Britain's Got Talent' style talent show!

Skoog Flash Cards
